Construction Update

Private Features in City Right-of-Way

We ask that residents locate private features in the City right-of-way so the contractor is made aware that there may be irrigation or invisible dog fences in the boulevard. The contractor will do their best to try to minimize damage to these systems and will repair during restoration.

Phase 1 - 170th Street

Traffic Control & Erosion Control:

- **Week of May 27: The contractor will begin setting up both traffic and erosion control on 170th Street.**

Temporary Water:

- **Week of May 27: The contractor will begin setting up temporary water on 170th Street for watermain lining.**
- Door hangers will be distributed to communicate to residents who will be affected.

If individual driveways are impacted by construction, residents will be notified via door hanger to discontinue use and for how long.

Please be cautious and reduce vehicle speeds when approaching crews working in the roadway. Construction personnel will notify drivers, via hand signals, when it is safe to pass around moving equipment.

Further updates will be provided as the project progresses. ***The schedule may be shifted due to weather and unexpected delays.***
