Construction Update

Private Features in City Right-of-Way

If you wish to protect private features from damage during construction, please temporarily remove them from the City right-of-way. At a minimum you should locate and mark all private underground features such as irrigation heads and dog fences. While this can help to mitigate damage to those systems, it is expected damage will occur if they are located in the City right-of-way where the contractor is working.

Phase 1 - Glacier Way

Traffic Control & Erosion Control:

- Contractor will be setting up both traffic and erosion control starting on Glacier Way on June 9.
- Sawcutting for storm work will occur on June 10.
- Storm sewer work begins on June 12.

If individual driveways are impacted by construction, residents will be notified via door hanger to discontinue use and for how long.

Please be cautious and reduce vehicle speeds when approaching crews working in the roadway. Construction personnel will notify drivers, via hand signals, when it is safe to pass around moving equipment.
