Construction Update

Private Features in City Right-of-Way

If you wish to protect private features from damage during construction, please temporarily remove them from the City right-of-way. At a minimum you should locate and mark all private underground features such as irrigation heads and dog fences. While this can help to mitigate damage to those systems, it is expected damage will occur if they are located in the City right-of-way where the contractor is working.

Phase 1 - Townhome neighborhood (177th, 178th, Glasgow Way)

- **Week of August 11:** No work scheduled at this time.
- **Week of August 18:** No work scheduled at this time.
- **Week of August 25:** Permanent turf establishment is scheduled to begin (weather dependent).

Phases 2 & 3 - Glacier Way, Glasgow Way and 175th Street

- **Week of August 11:** Removals will be marked out and locates completed in preparation for work starting up the following week.
- **Week of August 18:** Curb, pedestrian ramp and sidewalk removals will begin early in the week. Concrete installation will follow removals later in the week.
- **Week of August 25:** Concrete installation will continue followed by driveways and curb patching.

If individual driveways are impacted by construction, residents will be notified via door hanger to discontinue use and for how long.

Please be cautious and reduce vehicle speeds when approaching crews working in the roadway. Construction personnel will notify drivers, via hand signals, when it is safe to pass around moving equipment.

Further updates will be provided as the project progresses.
