### Private Features in City Right-of-Way

We ask that residents locate private features in the City right-of-way so the contractor is made aware that there may be irrigation or invisible dog fences in the boulevard. The contractor will do their best to try to minimize damage to these systems and will repair during restoration.

### Phase 1 - 170th Street & Hayes Avenue

#### Week of October 20:

- Please know that turf blanket for new grass is biodegradable and needs to stay in place. Due to the timing of the seeding the contractor will be out in the springtime to make sure turf is establishing properly.
- Grout filling of old watermain.
- Curb replacement in Harbor Ct., Havelock Ct. & 166th.
- Tolerancing gravel on Harbor Ct.
- **Paving first lift of pavement on Harbor Ct Friday Afternoon.**

#### Week of October 27:

- Restoration on 166th & Harbor Ct. along with miscellaneous spots throughout the project. Please know that turf blanket for new grass is biodegradable and needs to stay in place. Due to the timing of the seeding the contractor will be out in the springtime to make sure turf is establishing properly.
- Any remaining bituminous driveway work on Hayes, 170th & Harbor Ct.
- Raising any MH's or valves on 170th, Hayes and Harbor Ct (majority has been completed already).
- Minor pavement repairs on 170th and Hayes.
- Paving final wear course in the latter part of the week on Hayes, 170th & Harbor Ct **weather dependent.**

#### Week of November 3:

- Due to the timing of the seeding the contractor will be out in the springtime to make sure turf is establishing properly.
- Any minor cleanup and missed items will be taken care of.
- Striping on 170th and Hayes will be completed.

If individual driveways are impacted by construction, residents will be notified via door hanger to discontinue use and for how long.

Please be cautious and reduce vehicle speeds when approaching crews working in the roadway. Construction personnel will notify drivers, via hand signals, when it is safe to

pass around moving equipment.

Further updates will be provided as the project progresses. ***The schedule may be shifted due to weather and unexpected delays.***
